IED – Istituto Europeo di Design and “Aldo Galli” Academy of Fine Arts offer a maximum of 100 Scholarships to partially cover attendance fees for the Three-Year courses and the Five-Year course starting in October 2020.

Through the “Covid Fund”, the Francesco Morelli Foundation also offers a maximum of 50 Vouchers to support the families of the Scholarship winners in the most severe financial difficulty.

IED Turin offers a Scholarship for the course in Transportation Design, taught in Italian, in memory of Michele Bini, to keep his creative spark alive.

Procedure

To take part in the selection for the Scholarships, candidates must register and upload the material requested:

- **by 17 September 2020 at the latest**, for candidates resident in Italy,
- **by 11 September 2020 at the latest**, for candidates resident in Europe or in one of the countries listed in art. 2.2 of these Regulations

Step 1. Read these Regulations and the Requisites for Participation carefully

Step 2. Select the campus and the course you are applying for

Step 3. Register by filling in the form at ied.edu/scholarship-distances (and - only if you are interested in the Aldo Galli Academy – send an e-mail confirming your application to borsedistudio@accademiagalli.it). Once you register, you will receive an e-mail with the credentials to enter your personal area, where you can upload the documents requested.

Step 4. You will be contacted by your Advisor, who will send you all the information you need to take part in the online selection day, set for 22 September 2020 from 10.00 a.m.

Step 5. Take part in the online selection day, following the instructions you receive by e-mail.

Step 6. You will also be required to attend an online motivational interview on the date notified to you by your Advisor.

Step 7. If you are awarded a Scholarship, you will have 3 days to confirm your acceptance and 5 days to complete matriculation.

Step 8. If you are awarded a Scholarship, and if you have the necessary requisites, you will be placed on the ranking list for one of the 50 Francesco Morelli Foundation Vouchers

REGULATIONS

100 Scholarships 2020/2021

1. Introduction

- 1.1 IED – Istituto Europeo di Design S.p.A. (hereinafter IED) and I.L.E.M. srl “Aldo Galli” Academy of Fine Arts (hereinafter Galli Academy) intend to encourage applications from young, creative people by activating and promoting specific merit-based competitions for the award of Scholarships for their courses in the areas of design, fashion, visual arts, communication and restoration.
- 1.2 In keeping with this intention, IED and Galli Academy are promoting the “Distanze” Competition through the Website ied.edu/scholarship-distances (hereinafter the Website) and social media channels.
- 1.3 The aim of the competition is to award a maximum of **100 Scholarships** to partially cover attendance fees for the first year of the three-year courses offered by IED and the five-year course in Restoration of Galli Academy for the 2020-2021 academic year.
- 1.4 In addition, the Francesco Morelli Foundation intends to provide additional support for the families of Scholarship winners with an ISEEU (Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator for University Purposes) of less than € 30,000: 50 Vouchers are available for matriculation only for the first year of IED and Galli Academy courses for the 2020/21 academic year.
- 1.5 The merit-based competition “Distanze” (the “Competition”) is governed by these **Regulations**, and will take place, following the steps described below, starting from the date of publication of the Regulations, until **17 September 2020** for students resident in Italy, and until **11 September 2020** for students resident in Europe or in one of the countries listed in art. 2.2. The ranking list of winners will be published on the IED Website no later than **20 October 2020**.

2. Participation, admission requisites and documents requested

- 2.1 To take part in the Competition, candidates must register on the IED Website ied.edu/scholarship-distances and accept these Regulations.
- 2.2 Participation is reserved exclusively for Candidates aged 26 or under at 31 December 2020 and resident in Italy or in one of the following countries: Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, Croatia, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, UK (including the Isle of Man), Greece, Ireland, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Macedonia, Malta, Norway, the Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Czech Republic, Republic of San Marino, Slovakia, Spain, Switzerland, Turkey, Hungary, Albania, Andorra, Bosnia Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Gibraltar, Guernsey, Iceland, Jersey, Principality of Monaco, Romania, Serbia, Montenegro, Sweden.

- 2.3 Candidates must be aged 18 or over at 31 December 2020 and must have obtained a high school diploma by the end of September 2020. For requisites regarding foreign academic qualifications, see admission procedure ied.edu/admissions-italy/undergraduate.
- 2.4 To apply for a Scholarship, Candidates must demonstrate that they belong to an income bracket of no higher than €40,000, by presenting the ISEEU form or an ISEE corrente certification (if the employment or financial situation of the family has worsened compared to the calculation made for the standard ISEE certification). Candidates awarded a Scholarship who belong to an income bracket of €30,000 or lower may also apply for a Francesco Morelli Foundation Voucher.
- 2.5 ISEE certification may, in any case, be subject to verification on the part of the competent authorities. Untrue declarations will be subject to the application of the pertinent regulations in force, and the candidate will not be eligible for the award of a Scholarship or of any additional contributions.
- 2.6 Students who have already obtained a diploma from IED, Galli Academy or related schools may not take part in the selection.
- 2.7 Candidates must know the language the course is taught in, as established in the admission requisites (minimum B2 level of the CEFR).
- 2.8 In order to verify their suitability for the Course chosen, participants will be required to provide:
 - a letter of motivation in the language the course is to be taught in
 - a copy of their ID document
 - a certificate attesting to their knowledge of the language the course is taught in, if different from their mother tongue (alternatively, they may be interviewed in the pertinent language via Skype);
 - ISEEU or ISEE corrente certification
 - High school diploma, with mark, if already obtained, or provisional diploma certificate.
- 2.9 Employees or contract workers of IED and Galli Academy may not take part in the Competition.
- 2.10 By providing the personal data requested on the specific registration form, Candidates indicate that they are aware of the criminal penalties applicable for untrue statements, and must ensure the data they provide are accurate, complete, correct and true.
- 2.11 The aforementioned data will be processed as indicated in the data protection disclosure attached herewith, pursuant to Legislative Decree no. 2016/679. None of the data requested for registration may be considered sensitive data pursuant to the aforementioned Decree.
- 2.12 Candidates will be held liable for any damage or damaging consequences caused to IED and Galli Academy as a result of failure to observe the above.

3. Candidate Registration

3.1. Candidates can take part in the Competition by filling in the **registration form** and indicating one campus and one course only. Once they have received their access credentials, candidates must upload the documents requested (see art. 2.8 of these Regulations) in their Personal Area. For those interested in the Galli Academy only, confirmation of participation must be sent to borsedistudio@accademiagalli.it. The deadline for registration is

GMT+1 – time difference 23.59 of 17 September 2020

for students resident in Italy;

GMT+1 - time difference 23.59 of 11 September 2020

for students resident in Europe or in one of the countries listed in art. 2.2.

3.2 Each Candidate may apply for one campus and one course only.

3.3 By registering for the Competition, the Candidate accepts the content of these Regulations in full.

3.4 Candidates accept full responsibility for the truthfulness of the documents presented, specifically relieving IED and its assignees from all responsibility for verification and/or checks relating thereto.

3.5 Candidates agree to relieve IED and its assignees of all substantive and procedural liability, holding them harmless from any loss, damage, responsibility, cost or expenses, including legal expenses, that may derive from any breach of the preceding points of this article.

4. Scholarships and Vouchers

4.1 IED and Galli Academy are offering a maximum of **100 Scholarships** to partially cover the cost of one of the three-year courses and the five-year course on the Italian campuses for the 20/21 academic year. In addition, the Francesco Morelli Foundation is offering a maximum of **50 Vouchers** for those awarded the Scholarships in this Competition.

4.2 The Scholarships will be awarded – regardless of the course applied for – based on the result obtained in the online selection test and the motivational interview. If there is more than one Candidate with the same score in the final ranking, priority will be given to the Candidate account with the lower ISEE income certification. At its sole discretion, IED will evaluate the results of the tests with a commission (Jury) made up of members from IED.

4.3 IED reserves the right, at its sole discretion, not to award one or more Scholarships in the event it considers the Candidate profiles inadequate.

4.4 IED and Galli Academy reserve the right not to activate one or more Course in the event that matriculation numbers are insufficient, or in the event that, for any reason, the necessary teaching, logistic and administrative support required is no longer available. In such cases, the Scholarships contemplated for any Courses not activated will not be awarded, and winning Candidates will not be entitled to any compensation, refunds and/or indemnity of any kind.

4.5 Students awarded a Scholarship will maintain said Scholarship for the subsequent years of their course,

provided they pass all the examinations provided for on the curriculum for each year with an average mark of at least 28/30. If this condition is not met, the Scholarship will not be renewed.

4.6 The Scholarship allows students to enrol with a reduced fixed yearly fee of € 5000.00 (€ 2500 matriculation fee and € 2500.00 attendance fee).

4.8 The Scholarship will cover only part of the attendance fee, as indicated above. Accommodation and living expenses and all other costs necessary for attending the Courses must be paid by the winners.

4.9 In addition, the Francesco Morelli Foundation offers **50 Vouchers** worth € 3750 each only for the winners of the Scholarships offered in this Competition. The requirement for eligibility for the award of a Voucher is certified ISEE income of less than € 30,000. The ranking for the awarding of Vouchers to the Scholarship winners will prioritise the lower ISEE income, and for candidates with the same income, the mark obtained in the high school leaving diploma examination.

4.10 These reductions may not be combined with others offered by IED. Students who are already enrolled and have already been granted a reduction previously will be granted the reduction most favourable of the two.

5. Selection of winners

5.1 The selection day is set for **22 September** at 10.00 a.m., and will take place online, with a general knowledge test and a creative project test pertinent to the area of the Candidates' chosen course. An internal commission (a Jury composed of Executive and Teaching staff from the schools of Design, Fashion, Visual Arts, Communication and Restoration) will assess the results of the selection.

5.2 The assessment will be at the sole discretion of the Jury.

5.3 In order to bring out the talent of participants, IED and Galli Academy have established that the online aptitude test will not be of an academic nature or based on factual knowledge, nor will it be strictly or exclusively linked to the themes and instruments of the course Candidates are interested in. The total score obtained by Candidates in all parts of the test will be used to draw

up a separate final ranking list for each campus. For the aptitude test, the Jury will assign a score of 0 – 5 points according to the following criteria:

- problem solving
- relevance to the theme
- originality of the idea
- communication

5.4 Students who have obtained a minimum of 12 points will be invited to take an interview, during which they will be assessed further, with a score of 0 – 5 points assigned according to the following criteria:

- Motivation
- Sharpness of intellect and personal interests
- Aptitude for project design

The total score obtained by Candidates in both parts will be used to draw up a separate final ranking list for each campus.

5.5 Winners from an income bracket lower than € 30,000 will be placed on another ranking list in order of income, to compete for the 50 Francesco Morelli Foundation Vouchers for matriculation on the first year of the courses only.

5.6 Winners of the Scholarships and of any Vouchers awarded will receive e-mail notification from IED and Galli Academy staff, and must formally accept by replying to the e-mail address they received the notification from, within 3 days of receipt of said notification. Winners who fail to do so will be assumed to have automatically turned down the Scholarship and, where applicable the Voucher, which will therefore be automatically awarded to the next Candidate on the Ranking List. From the moment of acceptance, winners will have 5 days to submit their application for admission to the course chosen and pay the matriculation fee, in accordance with the pertinent matriculation procedure.

5.7 IED and Galli Academy reserve the right to withdraw the Scholarship if, once awarded, it becomes evident that the Candidate does not fulfil the requisites, or has behaved in such a way as to damage IED and Galli Academy, or that a winning candidate has breached these Regulations.

6. Exclusion of Guarantees

6.1 IED neither declares nor guarantees that the Website and its functions are “error-free”, or able to meet particular standards, requests or needs of the Candidate.

6.2 IED neither declares nor guarantees that the use of the Website and its functions will be prompt, uninterrupted, safe or error-free, or that the information and the content on the Website are correct, true and/or reliable.

6.3 In no event may IED be held liable vis-à-vis the Candidate and/or third parties for any consequential, incidental or indirect damage, or damage of any other nature, foreseeable or otherwise, deriving from the use of the Website or the inability to use it.

6.4 IED may not be held liable for inaccuracies or delayed performance due to reasons of force majeure.

6.5 IED may not be held liable for improper use of the Website, and does not guarantee or authorise the use of the same in applications liable to cause damage to

people or objects.

6.6 Candidates undertake to hold IED harmless from any and all consequences that may derive from the illicit, undue or unlawful use of the Website.

6.7 Consequently, Candidates declare that they are exclusively responsible vis-à-vis IED and third parties for anything that may constitute behaviour and or events subject to legal penalties with regard to the use of the Website.

7. Obligations of the Candidate

7.1 Candidates undertake:

- not to directly or indirectly divulge or transmit passwords and/or login names and/or any other access credentials to third parties;
- not to reproduce, duplicate, copy or distribute any parts of the Website, IED Content and Concepts published therein, in printed or electronic format, for commercial or other purposes.

7.2 It is forbidden for Candidates to:

- falsify their identity;
- supply or otherwise transmit any material containing viruses, codes, files or programs created to interrupt, destroy, damage or limit the functioning of the software, hardware, websites or telecommunication systems of IED or third parties.

8. Applicable law and court of jurisdiction

8.1 Any disputes (contractual or otherwise) that may emerge regarding the interpretation or execution of these Regulations, and any disputes connected with and/or deriving from the use of Website shall be governed exclusively by Italian law.

8.2 Any disputes (contractual or otherwise) that may emerge regarding the use of and access to the Website, or in relation to these Regulations, including those regarding the validity, interpretation, execution and resolution of the same shall be dealt with exclusively by the Court of Milan.
