Dear Students, dear Professors,

In the last few weeks, in IED Campuses and all over the Country, we are witnessing an exponential increase of Covid-19 infections: this new pandemic wave is a reason of extreme concern for everyone.

This is why we want to ensure that in all our Campuses **we keep monitoring the situation in order to take the best decisions to protect the health** of students, professors and employees at IED.

**We can confirm that all the activities and modules taking place in laboratories will be held in presence** as already planned for each Program, in full compliance with Health and Safety protocols and always following the Government directives.

The **other modules will be mainly delivered by DAD** and scheduled according to the specific needs of each Program, School and Campus until the beginning of the winter Exams Session (starting on the 31st of January), unless any new and different directions from the Health Authorities.

You will shortly receive from the Student Office of your Campus detailed schedule for each Program and **by January 20th you will be informed about the next exams session organization.**

We are updating the Covid-19 Management Scenario Guidelines in accordance with the requirements of the new Legislative Decree no. 229 (30/12/2021), the MdS circular no. 60136 (30/12/2021) and the new Government regulations (5/01/2022). Meanwhile, we like to remind you **the rules that must be respected** in order to prevent contagion:

- From Monday 10th of January, **it will be compulsory for everyone** (students, faculty and staff) **to wear FFP2 masks while in all the IED premises**, including outdoors (courtyards and gardens).
- It is forbidden to eat meals inside the indoor spaces of IED premises.
- It is forbidden to stay and gather in indoor spaces of IED premises at the end of lectures.

Finally, since yesterday's Council of Ministers (5th of January) introduced **compulsory Covid vaccination for all University personnel (professors and staff), from 15th of February** all IED Professors will be requested to exhibit their **Super Green Pass** to access IED premises (see [Government website](#)).
